The Netherlands CP Register

Your child has cerebral palsy (CP), a movement and posture disorder caused by a brain lesion during early development. Every child with CP is different. In order to better adapt the care to each individual child, we have developed the Netherlands CP register. This register collects data from all children with CP in the Netherlands.

You and your child can also participate in the register!

How does participation help?

The register helps the practitioner to monitor the development of your child, to detect problems in time, and to see whether a treatment has worked. The register also provides a great deal of knowledge about the long-term effects of treatments. This allows us to better anticipate which treatment works best for specific children with CP. You can access the data by using the register portal, so that you always remain up to date.

What data do we collect?

We do not include any additional data in the register: only information that the practitioner needs to provide the proper care. This includes data about CP, medical history, physical examination, psychosocial functioning, treatment information, and treatment results.

To be added by you: Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs)

For a good assessment of the treatment results and development of your child, it is important to have information from your side as well. That is why we ask you, together with your child, to enter a number of questionnaires in the register.

What happens to your child's data?

Data from all children with CP in the Netherlands are collected and compared. Your child's data is safely stored in the register. Only you and the person treating your child can view all the data, including personal information. Researchers only have access to anonymized data.
